## 2019-2020 Interdistrict Attendance (IDA) Transfer Application Process – Incoming Only

IDA Transfer Applications will only be accepted from June 1 – July 31, 2019 for the 2019-2020 school year.

IDA applications will be approved/denied no earlier than August 12, 2019.

Notification will come in the form of a letter in the mail from the District. No emails or phone calls will be made unless the application has been approved.

IDA applicants must provide a complete report card from the 2018-2019 school year that also reports attendance for the school year at time of applying.

IDA applicants must report any and all school suspensions and/or expulsions the student has ever received during their academic career. Notification must be done in writing at the time of applying.

IDA applicants must provide copies of any and all medical plans, 504's and/or IEP's at the time of applying.

Kindergarten IDA's must provide a copy of a completed pre-K assessment from the preschool/daycare provider by August 1, 2019.

IDA Applications that are denied will remain on file during the 2019-2020 school year and the District will make contact if space becomes available during the year. Please no phone calls or emails to check enrollment status.

IDA Transfer Applications will be reviewed based on the following criteria:

- 1. Does the requested grade level have space available considering Article V, Section A & Section C of the Certificated Contract that states Optimal Class Size and Impacted Class Sizes.
- 2. Does the applicant meet all academic, behavior and attendance requirements set forth in the IDA Attendance Transfer Agreement Contract.
- 3. If the applicant has a sibling(s) that is also applying as an IDA, they both must be eligible for acceptance. The Oak View Board of Trustees promotes keeping siblings together and encourages the "all or none" belief.

Approved IDA Transfer Applicants will have to follow the attached contract.

2.	Student must maintain a satisfactory record of citizenship. Student may not be suspended. A suspension may result in an immediate revokement of the interdistrict transfer agreement.	
3.	. Student must maintain a satisfactory record of academic progress. Students in 4-8 <sup>th</sup> grades need to maintain a 2.0	
cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 grade scale in all subjects or be meeting their Individualized Education Plan, or a general education 504 plan goals.
